Maths

Number - Multiplication and division

- *recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 3, 4 and 8 multiplication tables
- * write and calculate mathematical statements for multiplication and division using the multiplication tables that they know

Number - fractions

- *recognise, find, name and write fractions $\frac{1}{3}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{2}{4}$ and $\frac{3}{4}$ of a set of objects or quantity
- * write simple fractions, for example $\frac{1}{2}$ of $6 = 3$
- * recognise the equivalence of $\frac{2}{4}$ and $\frac{1}{2}$
- * count up and down in tenths
- * understand that fractions can be added together to make a whole (bar model examples)

Geography

Key Stage 1 revision:

- what are the continents and oceans of the world?
- what are the countries of the UK?
- What is the difference between weather and climate?
- What are the compass points and map symbols?
- What is the difference between physical and human features?
